Founder/Artistic Director, Ori World Dance & Culture Group, Glasgow; Founder/Artistic Director, The Descarga Dance Company, Glasgow/London; Selected to perform for Her Majesty The Queen at Westminster Abbey; 4 years principal dancer & Folklore choreographer with TVC Ballet National Company; 6 month world tour with West-End smash Lady Salsa; 3 years with Compania Oro Negro Dance Theatre, Cuba. 3 month internship with Tropicana Cabaret, Cuba. Guillermo performed Cuban salsa La Rueda at the Red salon competition PARA BAILAR CASINO in the Tropical Salon in Havana Cuba. He worked in the creation of dancing events for schools, weddings and shows in the tourist industry. He was a musician with the Cuban jazz band of Joaquin Betancourt as a percussionist of afro Cuban music. Today, Guillermo is a self-employed salsa teacher with his own company Salisbury Salsa. He teaches Latin dancing in schools for children of different ages and choreographs. He also provides dance classes for adults in events and special occasions such as weddings and anniversary parties and hen nights. Guillermo also works as a freelance Latin dance instructor with other companies, often performing Rumba, Mambo, Cha Cha Cha, Salsa, Reggaeton. He often DJs at events.
